

Chris Murphy's Waterbury Progress Report:

I want to make sure you know some of the good things happening for Waterbury.



1. Replacing old factories to attract new businesses.

With the help of \$600,000 in federal funds I recently helped secure, three old factories on Cherry Street are being replaced, which will attract new businesses and jobs – like the Bender Plumbing Co.'s expansion.



2. Building new ball fields with the Police Activity League.

With \$400,000 in federal grants, we're currently dismantling the old factory on Division Street and replacing it with new ball fields and a park. PAL hopes to have the new basketball courts open by this fall.



3. Helping local manufacturers with stronger Buy American laws.

To make sure our tax dollars create jobs here instead of overseas, I wrote the American Jobs Matter Act (HR 1354) which would require the Department of Defense to consider the impact on American jobs before awarding a contract.



4. Training unemployed workers and helping local companies hire them.

Working with Senator Blumenthal, I supported a \$5 million federal grant to help local manufacturers like Ward Leonard in Thomaston train and hire unemployed workers, while also giving them valuable skills.
